May make contribution which will be used to continue the program.</p>	<p>No Waiting List.</p>	<p>This program is staffed by volunteers. They try to assist as many people as possible but do not go out of the Ardmore Area. They are governed by a board made up of Churches in the Ardmore Area.</p>

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<p>Forsyth Medical Center - Whitaker Rehabilitation Center Adaptive Driving Program</p>	<p>The Driving Rehab Program serves people with the following conditions: Stroke, Amputations, Spinal Cord Injuries, Neurological Impairments, Visual Impairments, Cognitive Impairments, Orthopedic Conditions, Cardiac Conditions, Diabetes, Arthritic changes in upper and lower extremities, and Loss of function due to aging.</p> <p>Refer patients who are at least 16 years old and have previous driving experience.</p> <p>Must have a valid driver's license (<i>if license has been revoked, a provisional license can be obtained...</i>)</p> <p><b>A written referral from a physician is required.</b></p>	<p>An Occupational Therapist specially trained in the evaluation and training of driving skills will assist patients to return to independence with driving and community mobility. Evaluation includes: Driving History, Physical Assessment, Visual/Perceptual Assessment, Cognitive Assessment and On-road Assessment. The Occupational Therapist will determine whether training sessions are needed to improve specific skills and whether adaptive equipment is needed to improve safety.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Evaluation = \$200</li> <li>● In-Car instruction = \$100 (per treatment session)</li> </ul> <p>Funding sources include: private pay, worker's compensation, vocational rehabilitation. Designed to help determine if it is safe for an individual to resume or continue driving. To participate, an individual will need a written order from a physician and a current driver's license or permit.</p>	<p>An occupational therapist evaluates an individual's driving skills and assesses the need for special adaptive equipment if a loss of function has occurred. WFUBMC Adaptive Driving program provides an evaluation that helps individuals and those who care about them know when to get back to driving and whether special restrictions or equipment are needed to regain this independence. 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<p>Winston-Salem Transit Authority Regional Non-Emergency Medical Transportation</p> <p>727-2000</p>	<p>Bus services at 50cent one way, free to blue Medicaid recipients. For 60 years and older, or disabled and had ADA form from WSTA completed/signed/dated by physician and returned to WSTA. Anyone with Blue Medicaid card rides free.</p>	<p>To be transported anywhere. Do have wheelchair lift</p>	<p>50 cent one way, free to Medicaid recipients</p>	<p>One who uses wheelchair should notify WSTA so they will have enough buses to accommodate the wheelchairs.</p>	<p>Trans Aid provides transportation for medical appointments in Forsyth Co. The client must be age 60 or over, disabled and have documentation by doctor on ADA form or receive Medicaid. The cost is 50 cents each way and no charge for Medicaid recipients. Also provide transportation back.</p>	<p>Provide transportation services to and from these locations. Client cannot need help from PART employees. Client maybe able to bring someone to assist.</p>	<p>\$45 to airport \$65 round trip to Duke and Chapel Hill Be able to meet the PART bus, which has several locations in WS Duke and Chapel Hill If client receives Medicare or Medicaid the client must be certified by a Medicaid worker for authorization for the county to assist in payment.</p>	<p>Call to make appointment.</p>	<p>PART Out-of-Region Non-Emergency Medical (ph # 662-0002) only assist those who need transportation to medical apt. and/or surgery with Chapel Hill or Duke Hospitals.
