Students: Must be 18 years or older and *not* enrolled in a high school program. Each student's current reading skills are assessed at no charge. Sign up now—sessions begin in January.

Volunteer Tutors: We need patient people who are interested in helping others learn! Among our volunteers are siblings, parents, teachers, retirees, and community members. Tutors will be trained in January through the Literacy Initiative of the YMCA. A commitment to attend four 2.5 hour sessions is required. The fee of \$25 is paid through scholarships from Piedmont Down Syndrome Support Network.
