## **YADKIN VALLEY HEAD START (Other centers: Jones School Rd., Oak Grove Rd., Elkin, Paynetown Community Center, Red Hill Creek Community Center and Dobson)**

Serves children ages 3 to 5 years. Federally funded day care program with no fees. Families must meet federal income guidelines. Services include: structured educational setting, developmentally appropriate activities, medical/dental screenings and exams, and parent enrichment opportunities. (336) 367-7251
